CHAPTER 3 ADVERTISING (1)

Sec. 3-1. Use of sound tracks, loud speakers, etc., prohibited generally (2)

No person owning, leasing or operating any building, structure or vehicle shall play, use, operate or permit to be played, used or operated, any radio receiving sets, musical instruments, phonograph, loud-speaker, sound amplifier, sound track or other machine or device for producing or reproducing of sound for the purpose of advertising or attracting the attention of the public to such building, structure or vehicle.

Sec. 3-2. Posting Handbills

Anyone who shall paste up, stick up or post handbills, placards, or posters, or make print or make any word, letter or advertisement of any kind upon any private house, store or other building, telegraph, telephone or electric light post, or upon any fence, wall, railing or other private property without the consent of the owner thereof; or who shall paste up, stick up, nail up or post any handbills, placards or posters of any kind, or make paint or mark any word, character, or letter except in compliance with the requirements of law in the posting of legal notices, shall be guilty of a violation of this Code.

Sec. 3-3. Painting signs on sidewalk. (3)

It shall be unlawful for any person to paint any signs upon the sidewalks within the city, either with paint, chalk or other substance. This section shall have no application to authorized painting or marking of traffic instructions on city streets.

Sec. 3-4. Exceptions to Chapter

The city council at one of its regular meetings may make exceptions to the provisions of this chapter; provided that proper application is made to them while in session.

- 2. As to prohibition against noise generally, see Sec. 22-22 of this Code
- 3. As to signs erected on streets, boulevards, sidewalks, etc., see Sec. 25-3 of this Code.
